Late afternoon, weather permitting, we gather for tea and cake. This is when we share what we know of the area and discuss what we are going to do the following day. Please bring your own tea or coffee and feel free to take a cake from the table. Well behaved dogs on a short lead may be brought to the gathering but please keep them away from food.

If you join one of our walks bring a packed lunch, water and something for a late morning coffee stop. Take a packed lunch, water and snack if you join a group ride and expect a stop at a coffee shop if there is one along the route.

Please note that all walk and ride leaders are volunteers. Participation is at your own risk.

Ordnance Survey maps are available to borrow in the information tent if you want to explore the countryside on your own.

The steward will put a message on the information board to show when meet fees will be collected. Payment is by cash only.

Please be aware of the Camping and Caravanning Club rules that apply to all meets, including;

- Noise from radios, televisions and other sources should be kept to a minimum with no noise whatsoever between 11pm and 7am;
- Dogs and other pets must be kept under control at all times. No animal is allowed to be loose on the site and must be on a lead not more than two metres long, if outside a unit;
- Vehicle speeds must not exceed 5mph;
- The flying of kites, model aircraft and drones is forbidden.
- Unless advised otherwise by the Steward, please take your refuse away with you.

We also ask that you don't smoke or use an e-cigarette during afternoon tea or any other social gathering.
